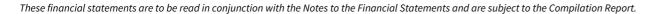

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# **Statement of Accounting Policies**

### NZ Hydrological Society Inc For the year ended 31 March 2025

#### **Basis of Preparation**

The entity is eligible to apply Tier 3 (NFP) Standard, which replaces the PBE SFR-A (NFP) Standard used prior to 1 April 2024. The entity has applied the Tier 3 (NFP) Standard - *Simple Format Reporting-Accrual (Not-For-Profit)* on the basis that it does not have public accountability and has total annual expenses of less than \$5,000,000.

All transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting.

The Performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the entity is a going concern and will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

All amounts are presented in New Zealand dollars and rounded to the nearest dollar.

#### Goods and Services Tax (GST)

The entity is registered for GST. The amounts recorded in the performance report are exclusive of GST (if any), except for debtors and creditors which are stated inclusive of GST.

#### **Income Tax**

NZ Hydrological Society Inc is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax as it is a scientific organisation under section CW49 of the Income Tax Act 2007.

### **Cash and Short-Term Deposits**

Cash and short-term deposits in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with original maturities of 90 days or less.

### **Investments**

Investments are carried at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Where in the entities' opinion there has been a permanent reduction in the value of the investments this has been brought to account in the current period. The term deposits are non-current investments as it is the intention of the entity to re-invest them upon maturity.

### **Changes in Accounting Policies**

This is the first period the entity has prepared the financial statements in accordance with the new Tier 3 (NFP) standard. Comparative information has been restated where necessary to comply with the new standard. The transition has not resulted in any material changes to the reported financial position or performance, except for changes in presentation and disclosure format.

#### Revenue

Revenue is recognised to the extent that it is probably that the economic benefit will flow to the entity and revenue can be reliably measured. Revenue shall be recorded on the occurrence of a recognition event. This is when there is a legal right to receive cash either now or sometime in the future. Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received.

#### The following specific recognition criteria must be met before revenue is recognised:

- Interest revenue is recognised as it accrues, using the effective interest method.
- Donations, Grants, and Service contracts are accounted for depending on whether there is a documented expectation
  over its use. Where there is no documented expectation, revenue is recorded as income when the cas is received. When
  there is a significant amount and documented expectation, the cash received is initially record as a liability on receipt.
  Income is subsequently recognised within the Statement of Financial Performance as the documented expectation is met.
- Sales of Services are recognised in the accounting period in which the services are rendered.
- Sales of Books are recognised in the accounting period in which the books are sold.

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### **Comparatives**

As a result of this change, comparative information has been taken from the Performance Report for the prior year.

Certain amounts in the comparative information have been reclassified to ensure consistency with the current year's presentation.

### **Accounts Receivable**

Receivables are stated at their estimated realisable value. Bad debts are written off in the year in which they are identified.

#### **Fixed Assets**

Fixed Assets have been included at cost less accumulated depreciation. Details of fixed assets are set out in the attached Schedule of Fixed Assets and Depreciation.

### **Project Funds Committed**

Project funds committed are expensed in the year in which the commitment is approved. Project funds are paid out to recipients upon satisfying the terms of the relevant contract.

#### Income in Advance

Income in advance is shown as received in the year that it relates to Income relating to an unexpired period, and is shown as a current liability.

### **Reporting Currency**

These financial statements of New Zealand Hydrological Society Inc are presented in New Zealand dollars.
